- Washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoiding touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoiding close contact with people who are sick.
- Staying home when you are sick. If you have trouble breathing, or a persistent fever, call your primary care provider.
- Covering your cough or sneeze with a tissue or your sleeve.
- Frequently cleaning and disinfecting touched objects and surfaces.
