PROJECT	SCHEDULE	DESCRIPTION
Bailey Boswell Overpass	Anticipated Construction Start: Beginning of August	2-lane overpass spanning Saginaw Boulevard and the railroad tracks on Bailey Boswell.
East McLeroy Curb and Gutter Replacement	Estimated Construction Completion: August 15, 2020	This project is reconstructing the concrete curb and gutter on East McLeroy in anticipation of the County repaving the main lanes of traffic with asphalt.
FM 156 Coordination and Utility Relocation	Construction Complete	This project relocated City utilities out of conflict with the TxDOT FM 156 reconstruction project.

PROJECT	SCHEDULE	DESCRIPTION
Knowles Drive (Phase 1)	Anticipated Design Completion: December 2020	Reconstruction of Knowles and addition of drainage improvements from Edwards Drive to approximately 300' south of Woodcrest Drive.
Knowles Drive (Phase 2)	Anticipated Design Completion: Spring 2021	Reconstruction of Knowles and addition of drainage improvements from approximately 300' south of Woodcrest Drive to approximately 300' south of McLeroy Boulevard.
Knowles Drive (Phase 3)	Anticipated Design Completion: Spring 2021	Reconstruction of Knowles and addition of drainage improvements from approximately 300' south of McLeroy Boulevard to Longhorn Road.
Old Decatur and WJ Boaz Intersection Improvements	Anticipated Design Completion: December 2020	Reconstruction WJ Boaz on the east side of the Old Decatur Intersection to add in left turn lane and improve traffic operations.
East Cement Creek Improvements	Estimated Project Advertisement: September 2020	Drainage improvements to East Cement Creek from approximately West McLeroy to Opal Street.
Saginaw Boulevard 16-Inch Water Line Phase 2	Estimated Project Advertisement: July 2020	Addition of a 16-inch water line from Palomino Drive and Saginaw Boulevard. east to approximately Sansom Boulevard.
ADA Transition Plan (Phase 3A)	Anticipated Project Completion: September 2020	Update to the current Americans with Disabilities Act Transition Plan. Phase 3A includes an online public access survey and mapping tool to receive public input in addition to evaluation of City signalized intersections and approximately 17 miles of sidewalk corridors.
