Saginaw is located in northwest Tarrant County, just north of downtown Fort Worth and incorporates 7.75 square miles. The City's current population is 22,380 with a rapidly growing and projected buildout estimated at 30,000+.



OUR DEPARTMENT

We respond to approximately 2300 calls for service annually operating from two fire stations with 30 total personnel and have earned an Insurance Services Organization (ISO) Class 2 rating.

Fire prevention and life and fire safety education are top priorities in our department. The Fire Marshal leads this effort with the full resources and effort of the entire fire department staff.

Being a modestly sized career department has historically required our Fire Marshal to remain integrally involved with training, incident response, assisting with supervision of shift personnel and sometimes serve in the role IC or Safety Officer for emergency incidents. These additional duties may or may not remain as part of the Fire Marshal's additional duties and responsibilities dependent upon qualifications and experience.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- ◆ Must be a US Citizen by birth or naturalization and at least 18 years of age
- ◆ Possess a High School Diploma or equivalent
- ◆ Standard visual acuity without correction, at least 20/40 in one eye and 20/100 in the other eye and correctable to at least 20/20 and 20/40
- ◆ Must be able to visually distinguish colors
- ◆ Hearing 15/15 without correction
- ◆ Must possess a valid Texas Driver's License and an excellent driving record
- ◆ TCFP Advanced Firefighter Certification
- ◆ TCFP Fire Inspector Certification
- ◆ TCFP Fire or Arson Investigator Certification
- ◆ TDSHS EMT Certification

Applicant(s) with the highest overall ranking may not necessarily be the final applicant(s) chosen. We reserve the right not to employ any applicant.
