SUBJECT: Action regarding Ordinance No. 2017-03, establishing a schedule of Library fines and

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

(CC-0417-03)

During the recent preparation of the annual codification of ordinances it was discovered that the library fines and fees are not included in the current City Code. An ordinance adopted in 1979 addressed fines and fees but that ordinance was replaced with Ordinance No. 97-7 which set up the Library Board. It included the rules for the use of library materials but the fines and fees were left out. Ordinance No. 2017-03 establishes a schedule of library fines. It was prepared by the City Attorney.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAGINAW, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A MASTER SCHEDULE OF FINES AND FEES FOR USE OF THE CITY'S PUBLIC LIBRARY; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Saginaw, Texas (the "City") is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City operates a public library for the use and enjoyment of the general public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary and desires to adopt a Master Schedule of Fines and Fees for use of said library.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAGINAW, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That a Master Schedule of Fines and Fees for use of the City's public library is hereby established. The new fines and fees are set forth in the attached and incorporated as Exhibit "A", hereto.

SECTION 2.

The Master Schedule of Fines and Fees shall be kept on file with the office of the City Secretary.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City and other applicable City ordinances, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the applicability of the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid

judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase.

SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
